**Menu:** The three-course prix fixe menu starts with an autumn vegetable soup garnished with ginger crème fraiche and puff pastry. The main course—roasted turkey from Willie Farms—is served with classic bread stuffing, mashed potatoes and gravy and cranberry relish, plus your choice of brussels sprouts, candied yams, green beans or creamed onions. Choose between the old-fashioned pumpkin or pecan pie for dessert. An a la carte menu is also available, featuring turkey alternatives like pan-roasted Loch Duart salmon (\$40) and seared filet mignon (\$58).
