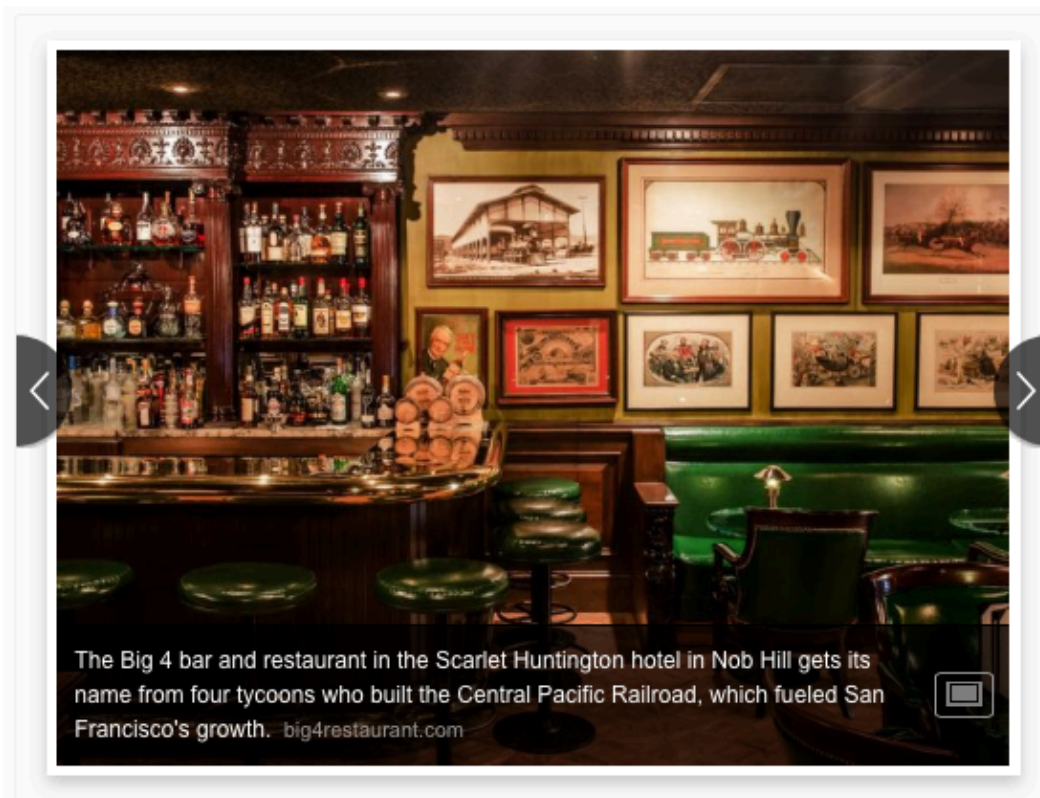


10Best: San Francisco sites for Super Bowl visitors
